Our bus service:

The meeting on Wednesday 28th April was well attended – standing room only. But if you missed it, here are the vital points:

Firstly, the present (Grosvenor) service is ceasing from 5th June; and there are two possible alternatives suggested, both would be run by Centro:

1 – a shuttle bus half-hourly in a loop from Cheswick to Woodlands, to link up with the No.5 and No.6 services running through Shirley. (The possibility of picking up at the Monkspath roundabout is considered too dangerous, with the Stratford Road to cross; or

2 – a route Cheswick – Woodland – St.James church, turning left along Stratford Road to Iceland, and there turning right up the Solihull Road to Solihull. (Not touching Monkspath Road). This would be an hourly service but would connect to both Shirley and Solihull.

On a show of hands the second option was chosen by a large majority: this result will go to Centro for their decision.

Committee meeting

The potholes on the road leading to the Surgery and the car park – deplored by everyone – were mentioned at the last Parish Council meeting. As the Mayor of Solihull was also there, perhaps we will get some action at last.

Neighbours are unhappy at the plans for two houses to replace the existing bungalow on the corner of Cheswick Way/Creynolds Lane – the other bungalows nearby would be overlooked and crowded.
